Central West Clinical Trials Unit Gets a Boost



Scientific Title: A Phase 1/2, Open-Label, Multicenter Study Evaluating the Safety, Tolerability, Pharmacokinetics and Efficacy of GB261 in Patients With Relapsed or Refractory B-Cell Non-Hodgkin Lymphoma and Chronic Lymphocytic Leukemia/Small Lymphocytic lymphoma.

Trial Summary: This is a Phase 1/2 study of GB261 in participants with relapsed or refractory B-cell NHL and CLL/SLL. The study will consist of a dose-escalation stage (Phase 1), an expansion stage (Phase 2a) and Phase 2b stage where participants will be enrolled into indication-specific cohorts.
